Revd Dr Christa Gäbler visits from Switzerland

During recent decades, the number of older people in Europe has increased dramatically. This development forms a challenge to politics and churches. Christa Gäbler gives an answer from a pastoral point of view. She herself has worked as a minister and authored two books on spiritual care of the elderly. At present, she is involved in a research project on religion and ageing.
